



Monthly Report for Human Rights Violations in Jerusalem

“Violations of Women's rights in Jerusalem”

MSD monitoring and documentation unit published its monthly report on human rights violations in Jerusalem; the detailed report presents all cases documented of Palestinian women's human rights violated in Jerusalem during the month of September as follows:

The Israeli occupation forces prepared a list of names of more than 60 women and called it the black list after the Israeli Police commander ordered to, in order to avoid women who cause troubles inside Al-Aqsa mosque. Consequently, each woman that tries to get access to the mosque needs to show her ID; and those who are on the black list are prevented from entering the mosque from 7 a.m until 3 p.m during the time settlers break into the mosque.

The Israeli occupation forces prevented worshipers from entering Al-Aqsa mosque to perform the daily prayers, therefore worshipers had to pray in front of its gates at the following dates and times: Fajer prayer on 13/9, Maghrib and Isha prayer on 21/9, Fajer until Isha prayer on 22/9, Fajer prayer on 23/9 due to preventing women under the age 40 from entering the mosque, Maghrib and Isha prayer on 27/9 due to preventing those under the age 50 from entering the mosque, Fajer until Isha prayer on 28-30/9.

“Moshe Yaalon”, Minister of the occupation's army, issued an order that bans what he called "Male and female Marabouts" at Al-Aqsa mosque, he announced that this is an illegal alliance that aims at causing disorder for the public security and prevents settlers from breaking into Al-Aqsa mosque.

The Israeli occupation forces attacked a group of Marabouts while they were present at the gates to Al-Aqsa mosque; they were beaten and sound bombs were fired towards them. Some of them were arrested and transferred to the police center in the old city.

The Israeli occupation authorities forced out a large number of Palestinians from AL-Aqsa mosque, more than 45 Palestinian residents inside the green line were completely forced out from Jerusalem, in addition to other 9 Jerusalemite women.

The Israeli occupation forces demolished a house that belongs to Al-Abbassi family in Silwan without prior notice, under the pretext of building without permit, the demolition caused the displacement of a family of 6 members including a woman and a child.

The Israeli occupation forces carried out several arrests throughout this month, these arrests targeted all groups, including 16 women amongst which 12 of them were arrested at the gates of Al-Aqsa mosque.
