



Quarterly report of violating women's rights in Jerusalem

(August-September)

Monitoring and documentation unit in MSD has issued its quarterly report of violations in Jerusalem city, the detailed report dealt with all registered cases of exposure of women's rights in Jerusalem during August and September which was mainly as follows:

- * The Israeli occupational forces forced the Jerusalemite citizen "W.SH." to self-demolish his own house on 2/8/2016. The house which is built of brick and tin consists of two rooms and related accessories, as the house owner mentioned that he, his wife and their 3 children have been displaced from the house which caused financial and psychological harm to the family especially the wife and children.
- * The occupational forces accompanied with the municipality crew demolished a house belongs to the citizen " W.A." in Sur Baher village on 30/8/2016 , 5 family members live in the an area of 120 square meters house, according to the house owner he was waiting for a hearing scheduled in court at the end of the upcoming October , but he was surprised by the demolition of his house without warning in that morning so he and his 5 family members " wife and kids" were displaced and homeless.
- * On Monday 8/8/2016 the occupational forces stormed the village of Silwan and began firing stun grenades and tear gas canisters, which led to an infant suffocation as a result of gas inhalation.
- * 3 extremist settlers assaulted the child "A.Sh." 13 years old while he was selling bagels "ka'ek" in the street, according to eyewitnesses, the 3 settlers got out of the car they were riding, they talked to him in Hebrew then they beat the child and ripped his shirt.

* On 2/8/2016 the Israeli occupational forces arrested 4 children between the ages of 13-17 years, from Silwan village in Jerusalem: the child "M.M", "A.A.N." and "M.A.N."

* On 9/8/2016 Israeli occupational forces arrested the child "I.Gh." 16 years from Silwan village while breaking into the house of his relatives in the the new street in Ras Al-Amoud neighborhood.

* On 10/8/2016 Israeli occupational forces arrested 3 children from Silwan and the old city and they are: "M.N.Sh." 15 years from Ras-Alamoud neighborhood, "M.N.Z." 16 years from Silwan and "I.K.A" 17 years from the old city of Jerusalem.

* On 23/9/2016 the Israeli occupational forces forced the citizen Suheir Abu Rmeleh from Silwan village to demolish her shop by herself under the threat of actual imprisonment and paying the costs of demolishing bulldozers , the is 35 meters area she built it to support her 9 members family.

* At dawn on Tuesday the Israeli municipality bulldozers demolished 2 residential buildings in Attour village as the municipality crews and dozens of special force, police and intelligence members accompanied by the bulldozers stormed Attour village at 3:00 a.m. and surrounded two buildings belong to 3 brothers, Jaser, Tayseer and Ahmad Abu Alhawa in Al-Khelwe region and closed the roads leading to them then the bulldozers broke into the area after demolishing one of the surrounding fences to get to the buildings in order to implement the decision of demolition. Tayseer Abu Alhawa said the occupational forces and the municipality crews stormed the apartments and drove out the residents by force and prevented them from taking out the contents of their homes and taking their personal belongings. He explained that each building consists of two floors and each floor is an apartment of about 180 square meters, he mentioned that the demolition caused the displacement of 21 individuals form the families: Bassa, Shweiki and Abu Alhawa who lived in these buildings.

* The Israeli municipality forced the Jerusalemite citizen Rami Alloun to demolish his house in Beit Hanina in the north of Jerusalem by himself under the pretext of building without a permit, Alloun explained that his house consists of two floors with the area of 340 square meters which has existed since 2013, in which he lives with his wife and his seven children.

* On 5/9/2016 the occupational Israeli forces arrested a Palestinian woman claiming she possessed a knife at the entrance of Al-Aqsa Mosque in Jerusalem, The Israeli news Web sites noted that The Israeli forces suspected the Palestinian woman at the entrance to the Al-Aqsa Mosque and when inspected they found a knife in her possession so she was arrested and transferred for investigation at the Israeli intelligence.
